Rules & Regulations

- 1. Two different groups/organizations may choose to walk together; however, each group/organization is required to pay a parade entry fee. (EX: Optimist Club/Rotary Club)
- 2. Parade line up begins PROMPTLY at 9:00 am. Parade begins at 11:00 am. Sharp, Saturday, August 19th! Someone from your group must be always present with their entry.
- 3. All entries with animals of any kind (horses, dogs, etc.) must provide their own "pooper scooper."
- 4. Maximum height on all entries is 12 feet. NO EXCEPTIONS
- 5. All distribution of flyers, printed materials, promotional items, candy, can be up to one hour before the parade or one hour after the parade.
- 6. All distribution of flyers, printed materials, promotional items, candy, must be HANDED out by walking along the curb or on the sidewalk. NOTHING is to be THROWN from a parade entry while traveling down the middle of the street to ensure the safety of the crowd along the parade route.
- 7. Parade announcements should be typed and attached to the form in the space provided. Announcements must be able to fit into the space provided. Parade Committee reserves the right to edit announcements in the interest of time.
- 8. Demonstrations in the parade must be moving at all times due to the length of the parade.
- 9. No gas, propane or hazardous material tankers permitted!
- 10. No entry will be allowed to exit the parade early!
- 11. Parade entries must be family friendly and suitable for children of all ages! The Parade Committee reserves the right to pull entries from the parade line at their discretion.
